CLASSES 22 - 31 ARE FREE

Admission to the public on the day is 50p per person (free for children and exhibitors)

WHAT DO YOU NEED TO KNOW? PLEASE READ

- Entries for classes 18-24 and 26, 27, 29 and 30 (art and crafts and poems) MUST be handed in to 1 Bellemoor Road, Shirley SO155JY between 3pm and 7pm on Thursday 22nd and Friday 23rd September and between 9am and midday on Saturday24th September. FOR THESE CLASSES PLEASE COMPLETE AND ATTACH AN ENTRY FORM AND ENCLOSE THE CORRECT ENTRY FEE (entry fee for adult classes only)
- All entries for other classes (food, flowers, vegetables and fruit) must be brought to Shirley Parish Hall on Sunday 25th September between 8.30am and 10am. After this time the hall will be closed for judging and reopened to the public at 11.30am. PLEASE BRING COMPLETED ENTRY FORM AND CORRECT ENTRY FEE
- The show will be closed to the public at 2.30pm when exhibits must be collected. Friends of St James Park will dispose of any exhibits not collected. Exhibitors MUST NOT remove their exhibits before 2.30pm
- Exhibitors may only enter one exhibit in any class.
- PLEASE BRING A COMPLETED ENTRY FORM AND CORRECT ENTRY FEE. Exhibitors must abide by the schedule and the ruling of the judges will be final.

PLEASE READ THE SCHEDULE CAREFULLY, ENSURING YOU UNDERSTAND THE TIMETABLE, CLASS REQUIREMENTS AND THAT YOU ENTER THE CORRECT INFORMATION ON THE ENTRY FORM.

CLASSES

Garden Vegetables and Fruit

- 1. Three home grown tomatoes
- 2. Three pieces of any one home grown vegetable
- 3. Longest home grown marrow
- 4. Longest home grown runner bean
- 5. A basket of home grown vegetables
- 6. Three apples of the same variety from your garden
- 7. A tied bunch of home grown mixed garden herbs
- 8. A most peculiar home grown vegetable

Flowers

- 9. Three of any one type of flower from your garden
- 10. One stem of a most fragrant rose
- 11. A vase of mixed flowers from your garden

Food

- 12. 4 fruit scones
- 13. 4 cheese scones
- 14. 8" Victoria Sandwich, jam filling, caster sugar on top
- 15. 4 Flapjacks
- 16. A fruitcake
- 17. 6 Decorated cupcakes

Arts and Crafts

- 18. A painting or drawing, in any medium on the theme 'St James Park'. Maximum size A3e
- 19. A photo (printed, colour or black and white) on the theme -'St James Park'. Maximum size A4
- 20. A poem on the theme 'St James Park'
- 21. A limerick (must contain the words 'St James Park')

Children's Classes

<u>0-4 years</u>

- 22. A decorated paper plate (paint and/or collage)
- 23. A painting (using fingers or brushes). Maximum size A3

<u>4-7 years</u>

- 24. A drawing or painting my favourite animal. Maximum size A3
- 25. 6 decorated biscuits

8-12 years

- 26. A drawing or painting on the theme 'St James Park'. Maximum size A3
- 27. A photo A photo (printed, colour or black and white) on the theme 'St James Park'. Maximum size A4
- 28. 6 decorated cupcakes

It is important that in the children's classes the work is solely by the child.

<u>RULES</u>

- This is a fun competition to help bring the community together. Any funds raised will help Friends of St James Park provide future activities and events in the park.
- Adults classes cost £1 per entry. Children's classes are free
- Winners will be awarded a certificate and respect from fellow exhibitors!
- All exhibitors will be given a hand stamp which will allow them free entry to the show between 11.30am and 2.30pm
- Judging will take place between 10 and 11.30am on Show Day
- All items MUST be collected after the show between 2.30 and 4pm
- All staging (vase, plate etc) must be provided by the entrant
- Entries should be made or grown by the entrant or crafted by their own hands within the last year
- All entries will be anonymous at judging
- All entries in food categories (apart from decorated cupcakes), will be tasted by the category judge
- A class card will be filled out and placed with name down next to exhibit. <u>No names should be visible on the exhibit. Please</u> <u>label plates of food or produce on the underside of plate etc.</u> <u>Art and craft classes must have the exhibitors name on reverse</u>
- Exhibitors may enter once in as many classes as they like.
- Judges' decisions will be final!
