

Community Club **S**tatistics

- Since January 2023 up to 24 July 2023 we have run 53 sessions and had 476 visitors. This is an average attendance of 9 guests per session, with the max visits being 19 visitors during a session (Staff not counted).
- We have had 476 visits from 69 unique visitors.
- Main reason for visit: Chat, art, board games and IT support
- We also signpost and support mental health
- Working closely with the So:Co Music Charity- They are currently running a 11-week course within the Community Club where we sing, play music and discuss music as well as make our own lyrics. This has had a huge impact on the people taking part, as people often use memories as lyrics thus it becomes like therapy. We have tissues ready for anyone who needs it.

- We, Friends of St. James' Park, are so proud to be part of the <u>SoCo MusicProject</u> and grateful for all the hard work they are doing! Thank you x



6 December 2022; Christmas wreath making






